RULES

Welcome to Lake Eufaula!

- Boat Check will begin at 3:30am!
- Check in by water @ flashing lights at the gas dock
- Safety First! Anytime your big motor is running you must be wearing a CG rated PFD! Kill Switch tethers must be worn when big motor is RUNNING AND IN GEAR!
- Please follow all posted water control signs and buoys! (If you're ticketed = DQ)
- Blast off at Safe Daylight - Approximately 5:15am!
- First Flight due in at 2:00pm

Welcome to Lake Eufaula

- **ALL boats must remain single file until you reach the channel**
- ALL bridges are IDLE ONLY.
- Chewalla Creek from the little bridge to the end of the creek is idle only.
- NO Fishing at the Coast Guard Station.
- The east bank at the Corp is off limits.
- NO FISHING at Chewala Marina.
- NO FISHING at the East Dam.
- No locking but you can fish the Lower Dam.
- Phenix City Dam – No closer than 800 ft.

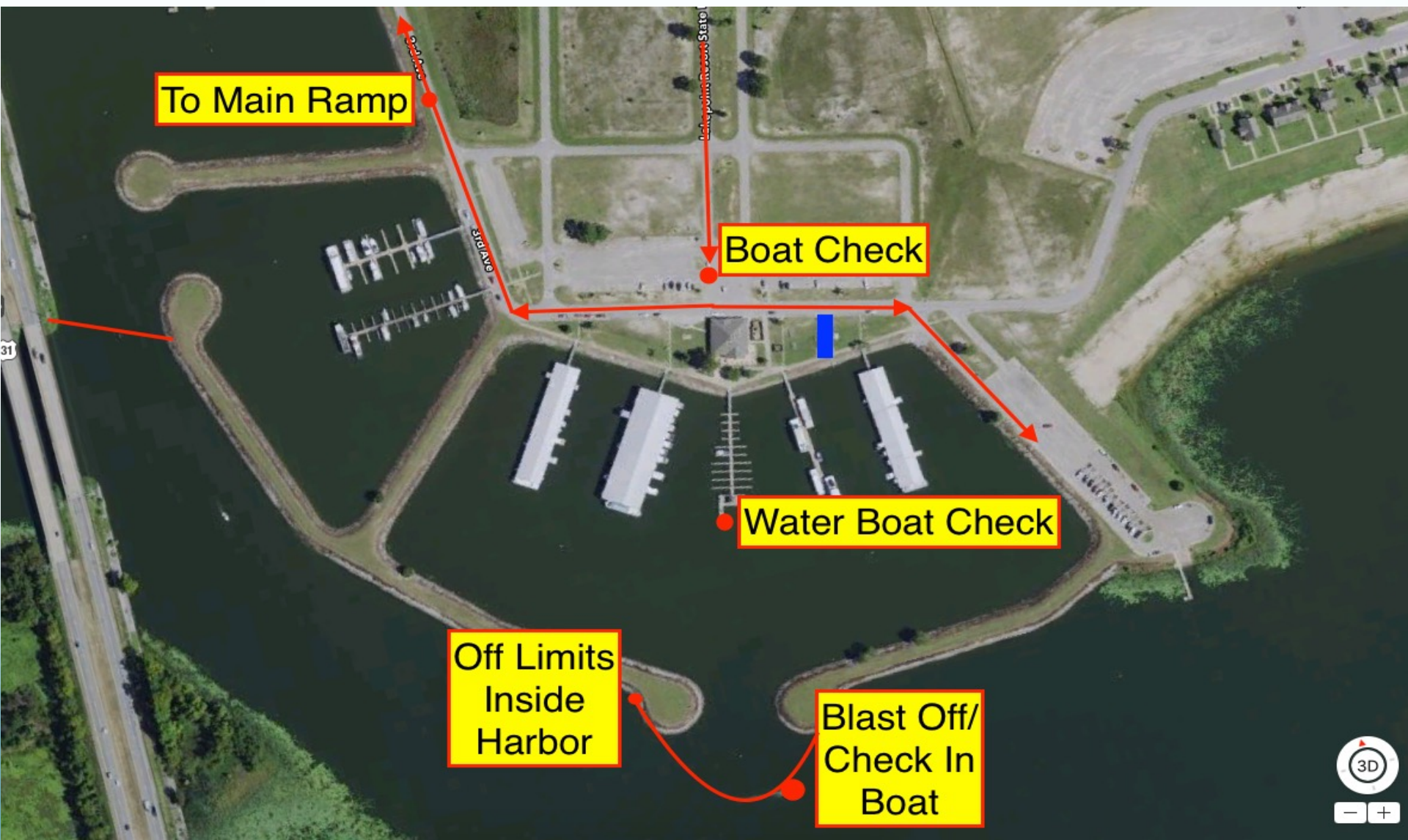
- Official practice days are on Thursday and Friday. During official practice, all tournament rules apply.
- All teams must be off the water by 6pm (CST) on Friday.
- When you arrive at Boat Check on Saturday morning, the team member in the vehicle's driver seat needs to have the text message with their team's boat number open on their phone.
- The vehicle's driver will be given a key fob at Boat Check. The key fob has the team's boat number.
- DO NOT LOSE YOUR KEY FOB!!! You must return the key fob at weigh-in in order to weigh your team's fish.
- This is not a trailered weigh-in.
